

Horseradish

Horseradish is a plant that grows like a carrot. If you plant it once it will grow every year if you don't till it up. In the fall, you would dig up as much as you need, clean, peel, and grind. Do it outside otherwise you will burn your eyes out. Interestingly, it can only be made in months ending with an R. (September, October, etc).

Brine: use 1 ½ c vinegar, 1 ½ - 2 c sugar, ½ c water, and a tsp salt. Boil and put over the ground horseradish. Cool. Put in small jars (baby food jars are a great size) and put it in the freezer.

If you put in freezer ASAP it will stay nice and white.
